BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

Line 01: ARTICLE I. The government must include everyone in selective services to

Line 02: increase our troops. The Department of Defense would be drafting those

Line 03: qualified who are in the age range of 18 to 25.

Line 04: ARTICLE II. A. Selective service registration is a list the government keeps with

Line 05: names of eligible individuals from which they draw in case of a national

Line 06: emergency requiring rapid expansion of our Armed Forces.

Line 07: B. "Everyone" is defined as all people who are physically qualified within the age

Line 08: limit, regardless of their sex and personal identification.

A Bill to Ban Tobacco for Future Generations in the United States

Be it enacted,

Line 01: ARTICLE I. A ban on tobacco will be implemented starting January 1, 2025. This
Line 02: bill will prevent anyone born on or after this date, from purchasing any tobacco
Line 03: product, eventually leading to a complete tobacco ban. Any persons who
Line 04: illegally sell to those who are addressed in this bill will be sentenced to jail for a
Line 05: maximum of ten years.

Line 06: ARTICLE II. Tobacco products that qualify are any that contain nicotine such as,
Line 07: cigarettes, vapes, e-cigarettes, cigars, etc.

Line 08: Nicotine is defined as an addictive stimulant found in tobacco products.

Line 09: ARTICLE III. The United States Food and Drug Administration for Tobacco

Line 10: Products will oversee and enforce the implementation of this bill.
