Be it enacted,

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in
2 Congress assembled that:

3 Article I: The United States will pull out all troops and funding from Myanmar and
4 increase sanctions.

5

6 Article II: Terminating assistance with no funds authorised from USAID and SAC.
7 Adding mandatory sanctions, freezing assets, and band on the U.S. financial
8 services along with visa bans. Require the treasury to impose blocking
9 sanctions on the military controlled energy sector.

11 Article III: The following bill is to be implemented immediately with a full transition by
12 2030 until any new law nulls it.

13

14 Article IV: U.S. Department of the Treasury's office of foreign assets control (OFAC),
15 shall oversee the law and have the right to end it if sought appropriate.

17 Article V: Any laws and policies in conflict with this new law are hereby deemed null
18 and void.

The Sanctuary City Prohibition Act

Be it enacted,

01 SECTION 1. In order to ensure the Rule of Law and the safety of
02 American citizens, no city shall be deemed as a sanctuary city
03 with the intent of circumventing federal, state, or local laws.

04

05 SECTION 2. For the purposes of this bill,
06 a sanctuary city shall refer to a city or jurisdiction in which
07 local resource use is prohibited and federal and state operations
08 are prohibited or obstructed by city or jurisdiction leadership
09 to enable illegal residence, activities, or behaviors by any persons,
10 to include but not limited to American citizens, non-citizens or
11 those without a visa or other legal status.

12 Further, circumventing federal or state laws shall refer
13 to a violation of a federal, state, or local law
14 by restricting or prohibiting local resource use or agency
15 operations.

16 a. If a city or jurisdiction is found to be intentionally
17 circumventing a law or obstructing or supporting the
18 obstruction of federal or state operations,
19 those deemed responsible, potentially including
20 elected officials (mayor, counsel, etc.)
21 of that city or jurisdiction, shall be charged with
22 any applicable crimes.

23 b. If an individual is currently illegally within the borders of
24 the U.S. or its territories and should so choose to
25 self-deport, they would not receive deportation status
26 and would therefore be able to reenter the country legally.

28 SECTION 3. The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) shall
29 oversee the enforcement of this bill as they oversee concerns
30 regarding those illegally residing in America, and would therefore
31 oversee the implementation of this bill.

32 a. Funding for the enforcement of this bill
33 would be specifically determined during
34 federal budgeting and would be included in
35 the funding for DHS operations.

37 SECTION 4. This bill will take effect on October 1, 2026.

A Bill to Increase Oversight of the DOJ

Be it enacted,

BE IT ENACTED HERE BY THE CONGRESS THAT:

ARTICLE I The federal government will create a independent review committee to review internal investigations within the DOJ, and mandate public reports from the DOJ on misconduct and disciplinary action against DOJ attorneys.

ARTICLE II This review committee will review cases of misconduct within the DOJ's internal investigations that include a employee at or above seniority of a GS 15, and all complaints of misconduct of DOJ attorneys. If they believe an investigation of the DOJ to be suspicious in its execution or findings, they will turn the case over to congress. If they believe that allegations against a DOJ attorney to have reasonable Merritt, the attorneys case will be moved to the state in which they are certified for further investigation.

The members of the review committee will be decided on by a 2/3rds vote in congress for state nominated candidates. The review board will have a max of 8 members with each member serving 6 year terms.

ARTICLE III The independent review committee will be mandated to submit public reports about their findings on all cases they review. The DOJ will also have to release public reports relating to internal investigations into DOJ attorneys. Sensitive material that could jeopardise the Nations' safety are to be redacted, but not be cause for an unpublished report.

ARTICLE IV This legislation will be carried out by congress, and funds will be allocated from the DOJ Budget. This legislation will be enacted on March 1st 2027.

A Bill to Reform Federal Tax Policy to Provide Fair Tax Relief for Middle and Lower Income Americans

Be it enacted,

SECTION 1. Federal income taxes shall be reduced for middle and lower income households while increasing tax rates on individuals earning more than \$500,000 annually.

SECTION 2. For the purposes of this legislation:

- (A) Income from \$0 to \$39,999 shall be taxed at a rate of 8%.
- (B) Income from \$40,000 to \$150,000 shall be taxed at a rate of 18%.
- (C) Income from \$150,001 to \$500,000 shall be taxed at a rate of 28%.
- (D) Income exceeding \$500,000 shall be taxed at a rate of 42%.

SECTION 3. The Internal Revenue Service shall oversee enforcement of this policy.

- (A) The agency shall adjust tax brackets and update federal tax guidelines to reflect the new policy.
- (B) Penalties for tax evasion or misreporting income will remain subject to existing federal tax enforcement procedures.

SECTION 4. This legislation will take effect on January 1, 2027. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

Line 01: Section 1. The Department of Justice (“The Department”) shall not be ordered or
Line 02: persuaded to drop charges, introduce charges, or otherwise influence the course of

A Bill to Protect Virginia Residential Emergency Repairs

Be it enacted,

SECTION 1. Residential landlords in the Commonwealth of Virginia must respond or acknowledge emergency repair requests affecting tenant health or safety within 24 hours

SECTION 2. "Emergency Repair" shall be defined as housing conditions that significantly affect tenant health or safety, including but not limited to the loss of heat, water, electricity, major plumbing failure, or mold or rodent infestation.
"Tenant" shall be defined as any individual renting or occupying a residential dwelling unit.
"Landlord" shall be defined as any individual or entity that owns or manages residential rental property.

SECTION 3. The Virginia Department of Housing and Community Development will oversee enforcement of this bill.

A.The department shall issue enforcement guidelines and accept tenant complaints regarding violations of this policy.

B.Disputes regarding repairs or rent increases may be resolved through Virginia's local housing authorities or the state court system.

SECTION 4. This legislation will take effect on January 1, 2027. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Reenact the Virginia Residential Landlord Tenant Act

Be it enacted,

Line 01: ARTICLE 1: The goal of this bill is to keep Virginia families in their homes and make sure those homes are safe.

Line 02: Too many people are evicted simply because they need a few extra days to get their paychecks.

Line 03: This bill gives renters more time to pay their rent and stops hidden fees.

Line 04: ARTICLE 2: "30 days notice" : A written warning giving a renter 30 days to pay late rent before a landlord can start a court case.

Line 05: "Junk Fees": Extra, hidden costs (like "processing fees") that aren't part of the actual rent.

Line 06: "Affirmative Defense" : A legal reason a renter can give in court to explain why they shouldn't be evicted.

Line 07: "Habitability & Repairs" : Landlords must maintain fit premises, including working

Line 08: heat, water, electricity, and sewage disposal. Repairs should generally be addressed within 21 days of notice.

Line 09: ARTICLE 3: A. Landlords must wait 30 days after a missed payment before filing for

Line 10: eviction. This gives workers time to get their next paycheck and catch up.

Line 11: B. All costs must be listed clearly on the first page of the lease. Landlords cannot

Line 12: charge "surprise" fees for basic things like paying rent online.

Line 13: C. Just like heat is required in the winter, air conditioning is now required in the

Line 14: summer. If the AC breaks and it's over 85 degrees outside, the landlord must start repairs within 72 hours.

Chronic wasting disease (CWD) prevention act

Be it enacted,

01 SECTION 1. In order to prevent the spread of 02 Chronic Wasting Disease
03 CWD) among the Virginia deer population to 04 maintain a population of
05 deer that are safe for humans to hunt and 06 eat, it shall be mandatory
07 that workers under the Virginia Department 08 of Wildlife Resources be
09 required to exterminate deer who are
10 infected with CWD. After a deer
11 suspected to have CWD has been
12 exterminated, the corpse and fecal
13 matter shall be brought to the Virginia
14 Department of Wildlife
15 Resources for testing to determine if the
16 organism did have CWD. In
17 the case that the deer should have CWD,
18 deer in the surrounding area
19 would be closely monitored to ensure that 20 all deer with the disease
21 are exterminated to protect the remainder of 22 the healthy deer
23 population. Authorized agents within the

25 to euthanize deer exhibiting symptoms
26 indicative of CWD or deer that
27 tested positive within the designated CWD 30 risk zone.

32 SECTION 2. "Chronic Wasting Disease" is a 33 transmissible spongiform
34 encephalopathy (TSE) that affects mainly
35 the American deer
36 population including the species of the deer 37 mule, white-tail deer,
38 red deer, sika deer, elk, caribou and moose. 39 TSE is caused by
40 misfolded proteins called prions and is
41 similar to Mad Cow Disease.
42 CWD is lethal, and has no current treatment. 43 Prions is a misfolded
44 protein that induces folding problems in
45 normal variants of the same
46 protein, leading to cellular death.

48 SECTION 3. The Virginia Department of
49 Wildlife Resources shall be
50 mandated to perform targeted lethal
51 management of infected deer in

52 areas where CWD is laboratory confirmed. 53 To reduce population and
54 monitor diseases, recreational hunting shall 55 be encouraged within the
56 CWD management area, subject to the
57 following regulation guidelines.
58 To prevent the spread of the prions, any
59 hunter who harvests a deer
60 within a designated CWD Management area 61 is prohibited from
62 transporting a whole carcass out of the
63 management area, and must
64 report the carcass to a DWR-authorized
65 testing station within 24
66 hours of the kill. The hunter shall then place 67 the corpse in a
68 biohazard bag and transport the bag to a
69 DWR-provided biohazard
70 disposal site. The corpse will then be
71 quartered by a VDOR officer
72 and removed of high-risk tissue and/or
73 head.
74 The Virginia Department of Wildlife
75 Resources shall pursue primary
76 source funding from the USDA Animal and 78 Plant Health Inspection
79 Service (APHIS) specifically designated for 80 CWD management and
